ACADEMIC REPORT:

Before we talk about our academic achievements, I would like to share the TEACHING METHODOLOGY that is followed by our school:

Since children learn better when they practically experience the knowledge that they receive through class teaching. Our school focuses on imparting experiential and research based learning where every child is given due attention.

Thus, apart from the curriculum being highly flexible and analytical, THE VITS SCHOOL works on simulating brains so as to ensure that children develop the ability to think creatively.

To implement this aim, Our School follows a 5-Step Teaching Methodology of Aim – Action – Analysis – Application and Assessment.

This methodology helps in developing high order thinking skills, confidence, effective communication and lifelong learning skills.

- We are given lot of opportunities to participate in all the Inter school competitions of Sahodaya Samagam,
- Few of our friends from 6, 7 and 8 had participated in Inter school Poem recitation Competition, conducted at The Bhawan's Prominent School.
- Many students participated in exams like Spell Bee, Olympiad and some are selected for Inter – school level.
- The students appeared for a Math Exam conducted by Byju's and we are happy to announce that two students got selected for the next round.
- Special Language enhancement classes from primary to middle classes to enhance their communication skills, are also included on a regular basis.
- We celebrated English Literary Week, in the month of July, which included the activities like- poem recitation, puppet show, radio show, extempore, story telling, debates, etc.
- As per CBSE norms, a new subject – Life Skills, is introduced to add completeness in the learning process. We, at VITS SCHOOL give due importance to this subject as it helps students recognize their voice, drivers and life. Ultimately, making them powerful and happy individuals.
- A large number of projects have been implemented in the year to emphasize on the concept of learning through doing for better concept penetration.
- To explore the class room learning in a practical manner, various educational excursions are organized. This year the students visited to:

- 11 students appeared and successfully cleared White Belt Grading Karate Exam, held at Daffodil School, Mhow.
- The school also participated in Sahodaya Samagam Inter School Basket Ball Tournament held at Shishukunj School. Here also, we qualified the first round.
- Last but not the least, our students had participated in the Inter school Skating Competition which was held at The Raj International School and five of them are selected for National Skates Competition to be held in Goa. Please give a big round of applause for our five stars.
