Near about 40 Ganesh Idols were made by our students and teachers from clay. Nowadays people use Plaster of Paris (POP) to make Ganesh Idols which do not dissolve in water. Moreover, they are painted with chemical colours that pollute water when the idols are immersed in water. Importance of using clay in making eco friendly Ganesha was explained to kids stressing on how their small step can be beneficial to our environment, indeed, imparting them a value education by doing so. A vote of thanks was offered to our guest who enlightened us with her knowledge.

Doctor's Visit

Dental Check Up

The team consisted of three doctors who first of all gave a presentation on basic oral hygiene. She insisted on brushing twice a day as well as flossing the teeth daily. What food is to be avoided to keep teeth healthy was also discussed. Presentations helped kids in understanding oral health better. Presentation was followed by oral examination of kids and necessary prescription was provided.*



Zoo Visit

A visit to zoo was organized on 7th October'17 for children and teachers. Children observed wild animals like lion, tiger and their cubs, hippopotamus, crocodile, alligator, python, deer, bear and various species of birds etc. Children were excited watching wild animals in front of them.
