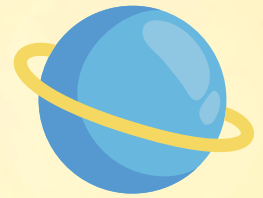

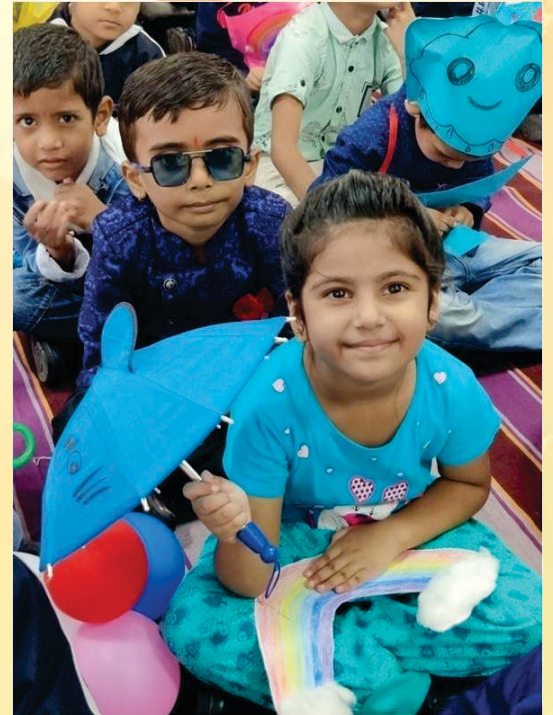
The Kindergarten section of

History of My School

School plays a very important role in a students' life. Its importance is very well known to all the students. Memories have been the part and parcel of my life, much like everyone else. I remember how my school has grown from a strength of just 67 in the opening year to 500+ students in the running year. I would want to share my experience with you of THE VITS SCHOOL as a student of its first batch.

THE VITS SCHOOL was established in 2016 by Mr. Sunil Senani and Dr. A.J Siddiqui as the director. From the beginning, all the teachers and the administrative staff were very supportive and well-qualified. The school is owned and managed by experts from the fields of IIT, IIM, BITS Pilani and Oxford (UK).

The first session of the school had very less students, which kept on doubling every year from the year of its establishment. I remember I joined VITS when I was in Grade 5 with two more of my classmates to now 26 of us in Grade 10.

The rapid success of the school inspires many parents and teachers, which is a matter of great importance to any institute to succeed. Our school provides us with best of infrastructural facilities like airy and spacious class rooms, huge play grounds for indoor and outdoor sports, an auditorium for various kinds of cultural and academic activities. My school has not only polished me and my schoolmates academically, but has also sensitized me to the core and has taught me to be a responsible citizen of my country.

In 2020, Covid -19 paved its way to our beautiful lives, and turned our world upside down. The virus has spread everywhere like a wild forest fire, and it took some time for everyone to adapt to the new normal. It resulted in the closure of schools and no further physical interaction of teachers with students. Fortunately, soon enough our school moved to online mode to resume our studies. As a result, education changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely on digital platforms instead of physical classrooms.

Teachers made sure that the learning for students was not compromised, so they took a great leap forward to find solutions and create new learning environments for their students to ensure that learning never stops. With little time to prepare, curriculums were modified, new lesson plans were created, activities were planned, all so that their students remain actively involved through online learning. Some of the students have been responding well to the active learning environment created online by the teachers whereas others need a push in fits and starts.

October 4 was a remarkable day for students as we went back to class after 20 months. Everything seemed the same yet different. The teachers were welcoming as they had missed us, too. The first few days, it was kind of awkward but then it felt really good to have offline lectures. Chocolates were distributed among students as a welcome-back gift and Children's day was celebrated. Copying from the blackboard, sneaking out of the classrooms, falling asleep in the last period, I could relive all these moments that had become memories.

It has indeed been an unforgettable journey which will remain in my heart forever. My school life is filled with lots of excitement and love. It made me understand the value of time and is a wonderful chapter in my life. Waiting to add more!

I find my school very sweet just like heaven on earth that prepare the small minds for many great tasks.

अहिल्याबाई होलकर का इतिहास

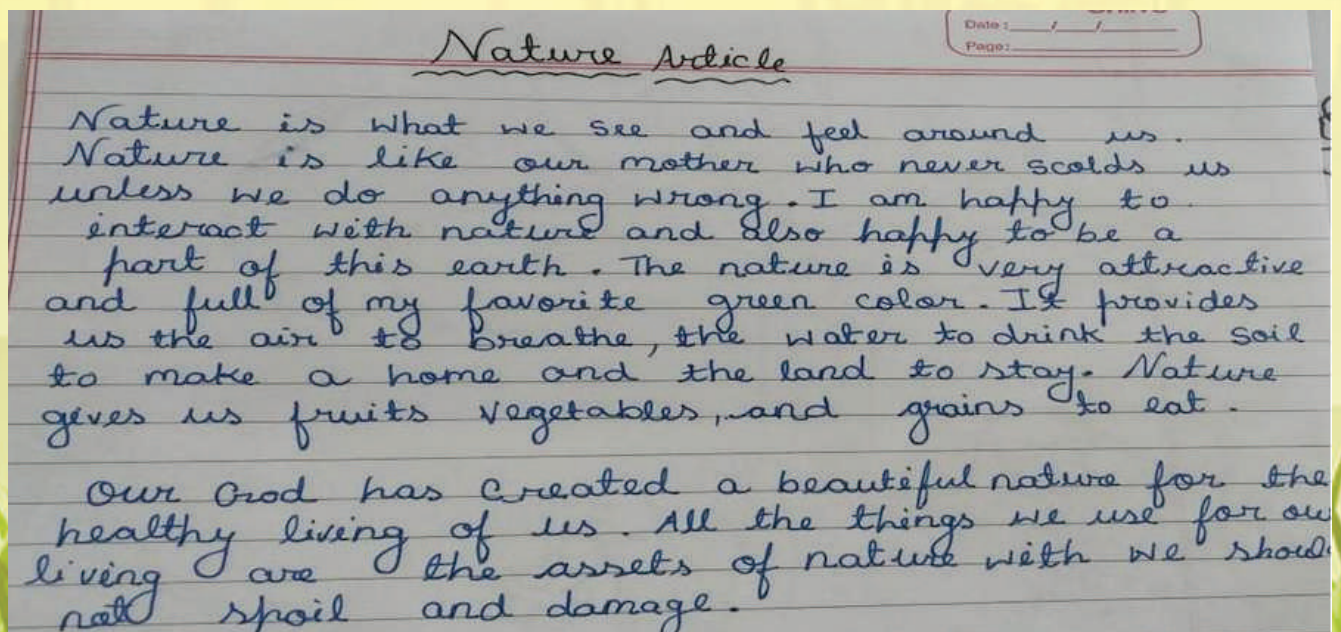
महाराणी अहिल्याबाई खंडेराव की पत्नी थी। इनका जन्म १७२५ में हुआ था। महाराणी अहिल्याबाई होलकर शासक के मालवा साम्राज्य की मशहूर होलकर महाराणी थी। अहिल्याबाई का जन्म ३१ मई १७२५ को महाराष्ट्र के अहमदनगर के छोड़ी ग्राम में हुआ। उनके पिता मंकोजी राव शिंदे, अपने गाँव के पाटिल थे। उस समय महिलाएँ स्कूल नहीं जाती थी। पर अहिल्याबाई के पिता ने उन्हें पढ़ाया और लिखाया। अहिल्याबाई के पति खंडेराव होलकर १७५४ में कुम्भेश्वर युद्ध में शहीद हो गए। उसके १२ साल बाद उनके ससुर मल्हार राव होलकर की मृत्यु हो गई। उसके एक साल बाद ही उन्हें मालवा साम्राज्य की महाराणी का ताज, महल पहनाया गया। रानी अहिल्याबाई ने अपने साम्राज्य में महेश्वर, और इन्दौर में धर्मशाला बनाई और मंदिर बनवाए जैसे की उज्जैन, गुजरात, नासिक इत्यादि।

PRESTIGIOUS MEDALS



→ Bharat Ratna

- It is the highest civilian award of India.
- It is rewarded in the recognition of exceptional service or performance of the highest order in any field of human endeavor.

→ Vir Chakra

- It is third in precedence in wartime gallantry awards.
- It is awarded for acts of conspicuous gallantry in the presence of the enemy in battlefields.



→ Padma Vibhushan

- It is the second highest civilian award.
- It is awarded for "exceptional and distinguished services".

→ Maha Vir Chakra

- It is India's second highest military award.
- It is awarded for displaying distinguished act of valour during wartime and the award is granted for "conspicuous bravery in the presence of the enemy".



→ Padma Bhushan

- It is the third highest civilian award.
- It is awarded for "distinguished service of a high order."

→ Param Vir Chakra

- It is India's highest military award.
- It is granted for most conspicuous acts of bravery in the presence of enemy, whether on land, sea or air.



→ Padma Shri

- It is India's 4th highest civilian award.
- It comprises a sanad (certificate) issued under the hand and seal of the President and a Medallion.

→ Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award

- It is the highest sporting honour of India.
- The recipient(s) is/are selected by committee constituted by the Ministry.
- The award comprises a medallion, a certificate and a cash prize of ₹ 25 Lakh.



→ Arjuna Award

- It is the 2nd highest sporting honour of India.
- Recipients are honoured for their good performance in sports for 4 years at international level.
- It includes a cash prize of ₹ 15 lakh.

→ Sahitya Akademi Award

- It is a literary honour of India.
- The award's purpose is to recognise and promote excellence in India writing.
- The award comprises a plaque and a cash of ₹ 1,00,000.
